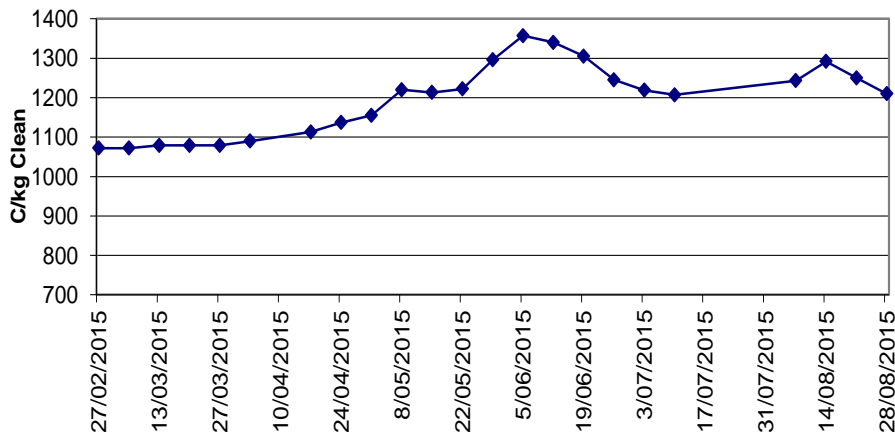

The disappointing wool market continued this week with not much joy for most. The AWEX-EMI lost 41¢ for the week, with the 19–23 micron wools most affected. A small selection of finer fleece wools attracted good trade support at a slightly lower level. The market showed some steadying late in the week with the Fremantle sale closing on a positive note. Late this week exporters were still looking to purchase wools either privately and/or electronically, which hopefully reflects a changing trend for all. Skirtings closed the week also easier with some types up to 30¢ clean behind last week's levels, but they were irregular. Crossbreds fared reasonably well on the back of only 1,227 bales offered for sale. The Carding market remained competitive and although some ground was given up these wool's still represent excellent value.
