## April Report

Disappointingly this is not a glowing report for April. Numbers per micron guide below illustrate not only the difficulty, but the unknown we face weekly trying to market wool to the best advantages for our clients. The COVID-19 pandemic is not only frustrating for growers trying to get wool marketed, but exporters are also finding it similarly frustrating trying to extract business. Wool post sale is now moving freely out of stores and payments to exporters are remaining steady which allows the cashflow to be utilised weekly. Wooltrade has provided the odd positive over recent weeks and together with a few good private sales, even low numbers nationally aren't allowing the market to settle. The industry even rostered a wool sale in the earlier scheduled Easter recess to keep volumes moderate post Easter, but even that exercise proved difficult. The positive is hopefully all clients are receiving some good rains for pastures and crops across all areas.
